## Paddle Power

Forget the A-list. Let's talk about Utah's sea-list. [Bear Lake State Park](#) is often referred to as the Caribbean of the Rockies. And it's rumored to have a comic-book style monster lurking beneath the tranquil turquoise surface, too. But don't worry. Isabella — as the locals named said Bear Lake Monster — has never turned a SUPer into supper. There are several outfitters located around the lake, including [Bear Lake Fun](#), that rent paddleboards, kayaks and other water toys. Motorized boats are also allowed at Bear Lake, making it a popular place to play for a day or chill for an entire week. On the opposite end of the state, [Sand Hollow State Park](#) offers warm water set against a red rock backdrop and ATV trails that go up and over a dune. Gear rental from [The Beach at Sand Hollow](#) is especially convenient for those who don't have an amphibious apparatus capable of navigating on land and water.
